

Many of our volunteers are young people.



Our History: Saying Yes to God

In reflecting on BBQ Mission's humble beginnings, God used the "long way around" to bring it where it is today. BBQ Mission's founder, Jeff Simpson, once asked God what more he should be doing with his life. After a lengthy conversation God responded with a question: "What do you like to do?" Jeff's answer, "I like to smoke and grill meat," and Jeff & Kate's willingness to say "yes" to God, sparked the ministry. Over the few years there was an unexpected explosion of joy-filled opportunities. They began serving at ten to twelve BBQ events each month. Jeff and Kate soon realized they could not do this alone and began praying for God to show them His plan and provide what He knew was needed. The ministry now has a steady stream of wonderful, dedicated volunteers who assist with set up, tear down, serving, prayer tent and sharing the love of Jesus. Now, nine years later, God continues to bless the ministry, working out each obstacle and building an amazing foundation for BBQ Mission year after year. With God's provision, our donors' unwavering support, and the help of faithful volunteers, more than 60,000 meals have been served throughout the life of the ministry. As our tenth year begins, we love the story God is writing and are excited about what is to come.

IMPACT STORY: LIVES CHANGED

Every life tells a story. This is a story of resilience, and a life impacted because of <u>your</u> generosity.

A vital component of BBQ Mission is the opportunity God provides each week to touch a life through prayer. Praying for someone is like making a deposit in an investment account. You invest, then patiently wait for God's response. Kelvin (pictured left) is one of our beloved clients. He has an infectious smile and a joyful disposition that easily endears him to others. One November morning, Kelvin approached us and said, "Would you pray for me?"

Like many others living on the streets, Kelvin had a job opportunity, but nowhere to store his belongings while he worked. This dilemma is part of the complicated experience of homelessness. It is hard to imagine having to keep every single possession safe by carrying it and protecting it every moment of every day. But our God is the ultimate problem solver. In our prayer, we praised God for Kelvin and we spent time reminding him that he (having professed faith in Jesus) belongs to God.

We prayed a bold prayer for housing and a secure job for Kelvin. After a few weeks, we asked Kelvin if his prayer had been answered. Kelvin responded with "not yet but close." He maintained his positive outlook and we prayed again.

After several more weeks, we were thrilled when Kelvin returned to BBQ Mission with the amazing news that he had found housing and started his new job. We rejoiced with Kelvin and prayed that as Kelvin reconnects with living a life full of purpose and meaning, God would continue to show him love and faithfulness. From time to time, Kelvin still comes to share in a meal. He is welcomed with a hug and a blessing. His presence encourages us and the others we serve. Today, 9 months later, Kelvin has stable housing and contributes to the goodness of our community. Thank you for being a vital part of BBQ Mission. Your generosity and partnership spreads warmth, safety, and love to our homeless friends.
